

Hendo's Hope Scholarship

The Hendo's Hope Scholarship was established by Henderson Lentz, as an effort to promote awareness for CPR, Automated External Defibrillators (AED) and to encourage athletes to pursue their hopes and dreams no matter what obstacles or adversity they face.

On June 16, 2015, Henderson was participating in a basketball team event at Catawba College when he suffered Cardiac Arrest. CPR was performed for approximately 11 minutes and a single AED shock was successful. Thankfully, he was resuscitated and his life was fully restored. This scholarship is in honor of Hendo's lifesaving team of good Samaritans (Hendo's Heroes) that responded with bystander CPR. Henderson was blessed by God to continue to see his athletic goals and hopes fulfilled.

Henderson graduated from North Rowan High School in 2017. He was a member of the varsity basketball and baseball team. Henderson has a love for all sports, but he is especially avid basketball player. He was always striving to improve his basketball skills both during the season and the off season as well. He is a hard worker and committed to bettering himself so that he could one day fulfill his dream of playing basketball and baseball at a higher level. Currently, he is a sophomore at Catawba College and a member of both the basketball and baseball teams.

The Hendo's Hope Foundation endows this scholarship to one (or more) Rowan County High School graduating seniors. Applicants for this scholarship must be graduating with a minimum of a 2.5 Weighted Grade Point Average (GPA) and participated in at least one Varsity sport, including Cheerleading. Interviews may be requested of the top applicants.

The deadline to apply for the scholarship is May 1st of each year. The scholarship will be announced at the senior class awards ceremony. The scholarship is typically a onetime award of \$500.
